



## 2020 Mission Trip Info

Service Trip dates: **January 18-25, 2020**

Block that week on your calendars now.  
You won't want to miss this!

**Commitment date: June 10, 2019**

There are a number of things that need to be done prior to the trip and some of these take some time so we will need a commitment of those who are going by June 10, 2019.

Submission of a completed "Service Team Registration Form" (page 3) and \$150 deposit will indicate commitment.

Submit registration form to the Stumptown Office. We will register together.

Here is a run-down of the needs and expectations.

Everyone who goes on the mission trip is expected to commit to the following:

- **Attend and fully participate in the planning meetings**  
As we prepare to go in this mission trip it is important that we build strong relationships. We will have a number of meetings to prepare for the trip including language, some prep for the work, and a little orientation to the culture.
- **Commit to fundraising.**  
The cost of the trip is significant but we don't want to have the cost keep anyone from going. We have some time and the congregation is supportive. If we all work together, we can cover much of the cost. You will be expected give full commitment and energy to our fundraising events. Details for each event will be provided.
- **Orientation meeting – TBD**  
We will look to arrange to have Dr. Herman Sagastume will be with to provide an orientation. This is mandatory to all who are going. He will provide a lot of great info for the trip.
- **Apply for a Passport (if needed)**  
If you don't have a passport or it is soon expiring (within 6 months of the time of travel), begin to apply for one now. We can help you with the process if you need it. Passports typically take 4-6 weeks to process but don't wait, begin the application process as soon as possible.

Those who are not carrying a United States passport, we may need to obtain visas in advance of the trip. This process is not for the faint of heart but we can get it done.

- **Get your shots**

You will need to be up to date on:

Tetanus (most people have this up to date but confirm you are current)

Hepatitis A

Hepatitis B

Or Hepatitis A/B combo. (this is a series of injections over 6 months, begin ASAP)

Typhoid (oral or injection) – this is obtained at a travel clinic and is taken about 30 days before departure.

Most insurances cover the Hepatitis A, B, and Tetanus.

- **Costs**

Mission Trip Fee - \$150 Registration fee + \$850 Fee = \$1000

Airfare: Approx. \$800

Total Cost for the trip per person: \$1800

Reminder: We will be doing fundraising to offset the trip cost.

All transportation, meals, lodging, and etc. are included.

You may need a small amount of pocket money for any souvenirs and food on travel days.
